Exhibition Dates:

29 September 2018 to 5 January 2019

Handing in Dates: 13, 14 and 15 September

We are delighted to invite artists to submit works for the 20-21 Centre Open Exhibition 2018. Both amateur and professional artists over the age of 16 living within the Humber and Lincolnshire region (DN, LN or HU postcode areas) are eligible to submit up to three artworks per person for the exhibition. Our independent judges will select the best works to be exhibited and to win one of our prizes.

A prize of £500 plus a professionally produced artist-profile video produced by KNOW MEDIA, and an opportunity to exhibit at 20-21 will be on offer for the overall winner.

Runners-up will receive cash prizes sponsored by local businesses, including a cash prize for our visitors' favourite in our Visitors' Choice award sponsored by Bewley's. There will also be a £200 prize to the best student entry sponsored by G.S. Kelsey Ltd.

Submitting Work

Up to three artworks can be entered per person. There are two classes for submission.

Class I: Painting, printing, drawing, photography and digital media (sound or video etc).

Class II: Sculpture, ceramics, 3D works and works measuring over 2m in any direction.

Submitting Class I artworks

Work must be delivered to 20-21, with a completed entry form (available shortly) and payment, on **Thursday 13 Friday 14 and Saturday 15 September** between 10am and 4pm. Works in film or video should be supplied in DVD format, or by supplying a link to the work via an online video site such as Vimeo or YouTube.

Submitting Class II artworks

(Sculpture, 3D and oversize works) Work can be entered by sending up to six good quality photos or digital images, along with a completed entry form and payment to **20-21 Visual Arts Centre, Church Square, Scunthorpe DN15 6TB** by Friday 14 September. Cheques should be made out to North Lincolnshire Council, or the fee can be paid at 20-21 reception desk. Selected Class II work must be delivered to 20-21 between the 25 and 28 September.

Who Can Apply?

Anyone 16 years of age or over resident at an address with a Doncaster (DN), Lincolnshire (LN) or Hull (HU) Postcode. Entrants to the Student Prize should tick the relevant box on their application form.

Cost: There will be an entry fee of £5.00 per artwork, £2.50 concessions (unemployed, students, pensioners. Proof required in all cases at time of entry). Acceptance to the final exhibition is not guaranteed and fees are not refundable.

Conditions:

- Class I work must be either framed or on stretched canvas, with a means to secure the work with 'mirror plates'.
- Large oversized works measuring over 2m in any direction should be submitted as Class II work (photographic documentation), please do not bring these works to the gallery prior to selection
- All works should be unpacked on delivery and the packaging taken away.
- Please remove all hangers and fittings from the back of artworks and mark 'TOP' on the rear of the work.
- 'Clip' frames, metal or plastic frames are not permitted.

Judging:

A panel of independent judges will select works and prizewinners in the week beginning 17 September. This year's judges include artist and director of Oriel Davies gallery, Wales, Steffan Jones-Hughes and current 20-21 exhibiting artist Jason Wilsher-Mills.

Collection of Artworks: Any **unselected** work must be collected between **Saturday 6 and Saturday 13 October**. Work **selected** for the exhibition must remain at 20-21 until the close of the exhibition and collected between **Thursday 10 and Saturday 12 Jan.**

Insurance: Works are submitted at the owner's own risk and 20-21 is not liable for damage caused during delivery, storage and selection. It is the responsibility of the artist to arrange insurance cover during these times if necessary. All selected work will be fully insured during the exhibition period. If an artist fails to include a value of work on the entry form this work will not be insured.
