Motionhouse *Charge*

Tuesday 6th November 7.30pm at The Baths Hall

Workshops: w/c 29th October in advance of their performance, schools are invited to book workshops with Motionhouse, providing all young people with the opportunity to work with a professional dancer, learn about the themes of the show, be inspired by science and improve their own movement skills.

Performance: Motionhouse will perform their exciting fusion of dance and science *Charge* at The Baths Hall at 7.30pm on Tuesday 6th November, inspired by the role of electricity in the human body. This multi-media show uses digital projections to create a world on stage where dancers and images interact. The performance will be followed by an opportunity to meet the Director and dancers, to discuss about the show and ask questions.

Education Pack: As a unique collaboration that draws together art and science, *Charge* is ideally placed to engage young people with scientific themes and ignite a curiosity and interest in the bio-electricity of their own bodies. Teaching Resources related to *Charge*, provided by Motionhouse include: scene-by-scene analysis and interpretation; 30+ questions and research tasks; behind the scenes rehearsal footage and interviews; and 12 fully-developed practical workshops examining *Charge* ideas and techniques.

Book a full day workshop (or 2 x half days to fit in with your timetable), **receive 25 complimentary tickets to *Charge* and a copy of the comprehensive education pack, all for £300** (a half day workshop is also available as a package with tickets for £200). James Wilton Dance *Leviathan*

Friday 9th November 7.30pm at Barton Assembly Rooms

Workshops: w/c 5th or 12th/15th November, book a workshop with James Wilton Dance. These energetic, engaging and inspiring sessions explore the physicality of movement seen in the performance, which shares a lot in common with martial arts and capoeira. The workshops are accessible and enjoyable for participants, whilst still being fresh, new and challenging. James and his company stand as exceptional role models for boys and are excellent at encouraging boys who have not danced before to take an interest in dance. Workshops begin with warm-up games that focus the participants and encourage team building. Following this there will be a contemporary dance class, breaking down how to use the floor in Wilton's unique style. Participants will also have the opportunity to learn phrases from Wilton's new touring work *Leviathan*. This energetic repertoire will inspire and challenge students with its physicality and intricacy.

Performance: James Wilton Dance will perform *Leviathan* at Barton Assembly Rooms on Friday 9th November from 7.30pm. The work, based on Herman Melville's seminal novel *Moby Dick*, features a cast of 7, with Wilton's trademark blend of athletic dance, martial arts, capoeira and partner-work. *Leviathan* will have you on the edge of your seat and gasping for air, under the sheer ferocity of movement, all accompanied by a powerful electro-rock soundtrack by Lunatic Soul.
